



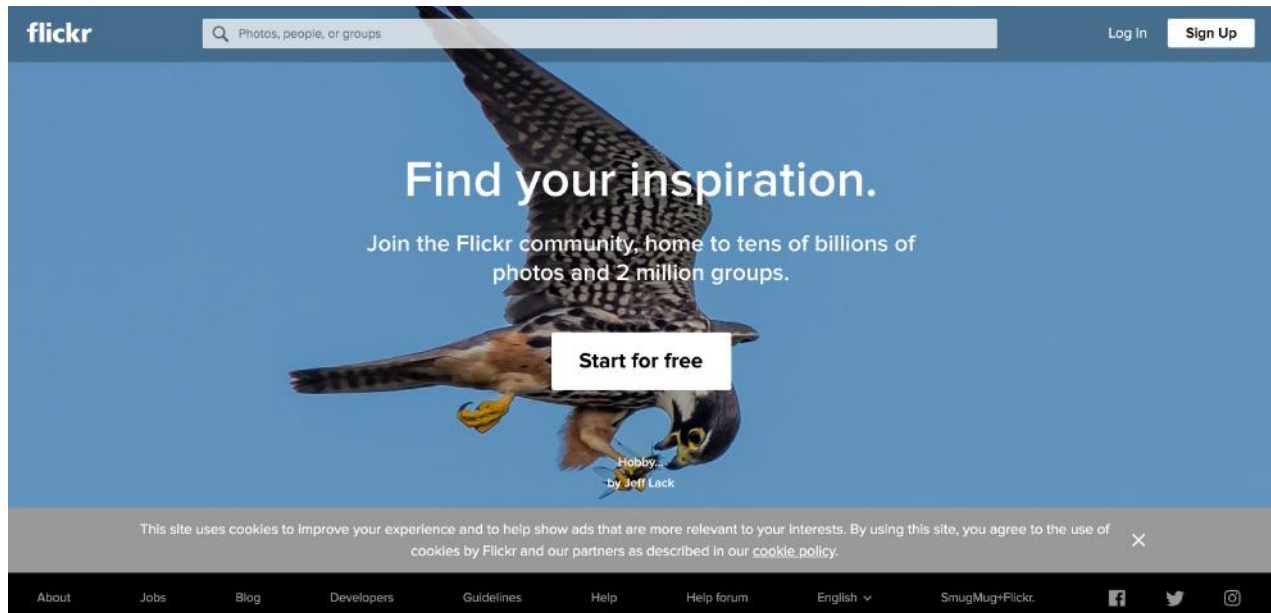

# FLICKR GUIDE



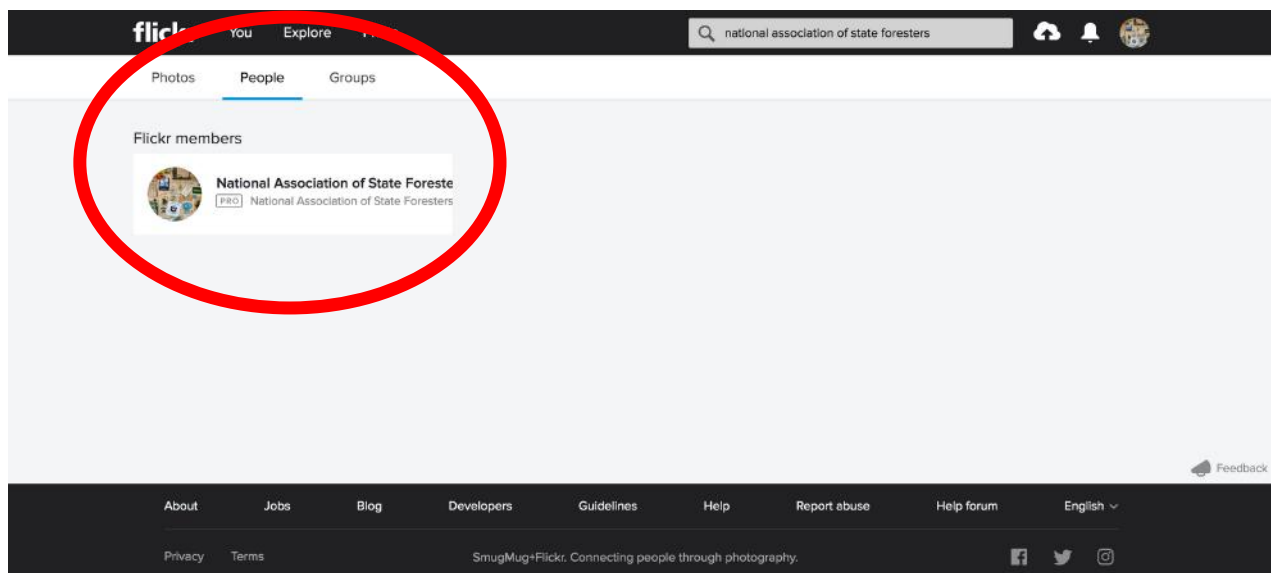

Go to Flickr's website (www.flickr.com). Whether you have an account or not, simply search for "National Association of State Foresters" in the search bar that appears on the homepage (below is how the homepage appears for non-account holders).



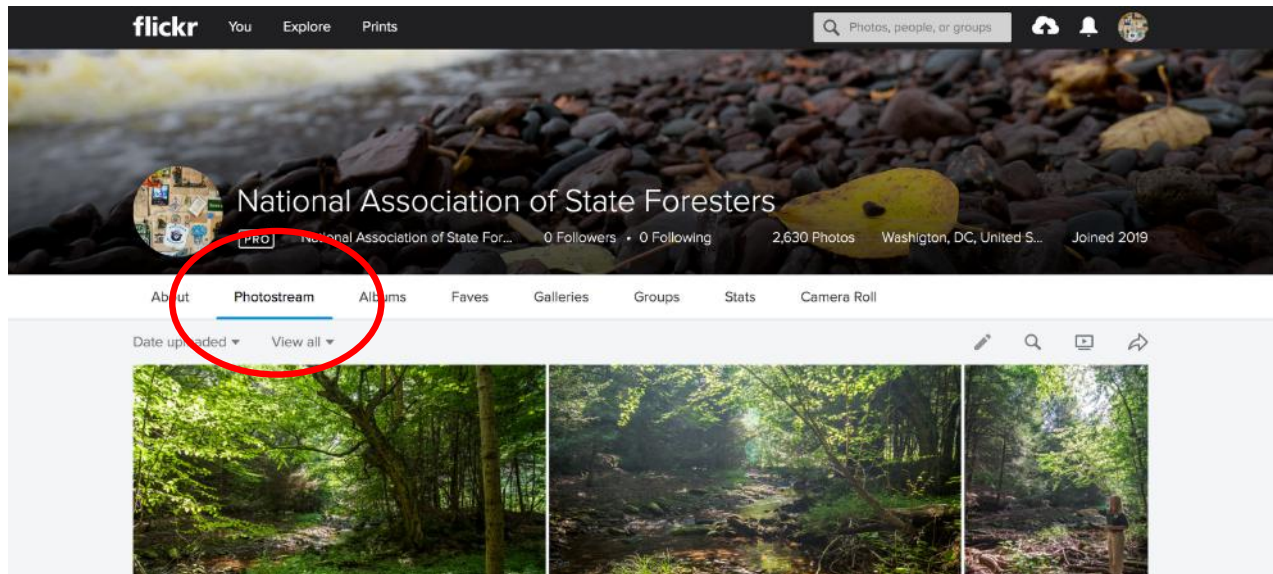

Once you've searched for "National Association of State Foresters," click the "People" tab to filter your results. NASF's profile will appear; click it!



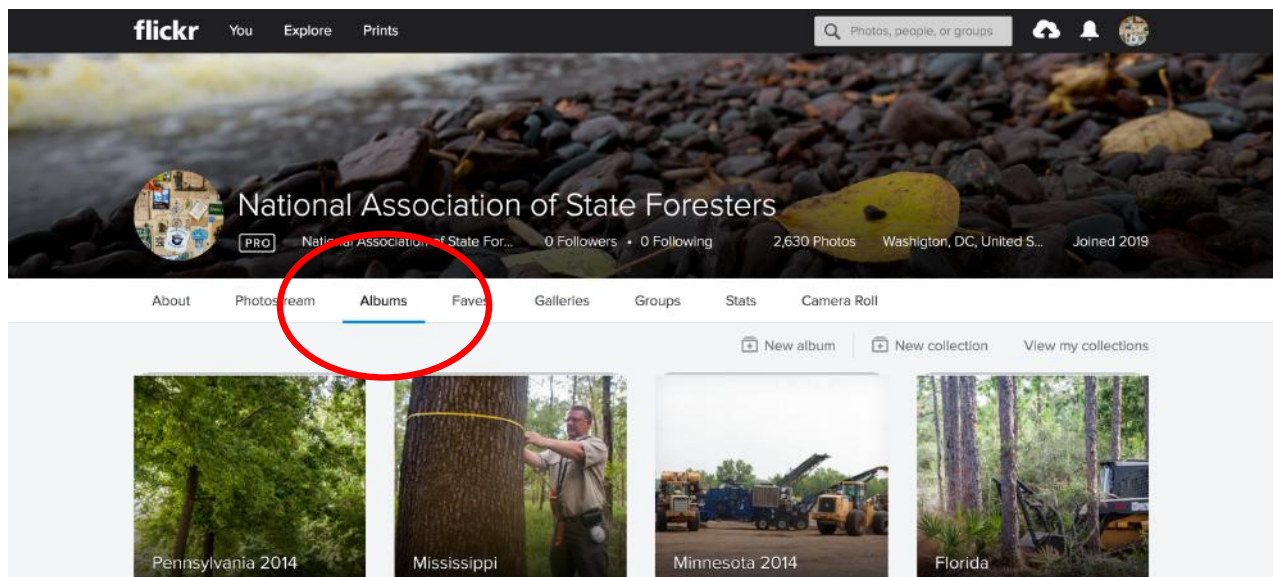

You can view NASF photos by browsing the account's albums or by searching for keywords in the photo stream (pictured below).



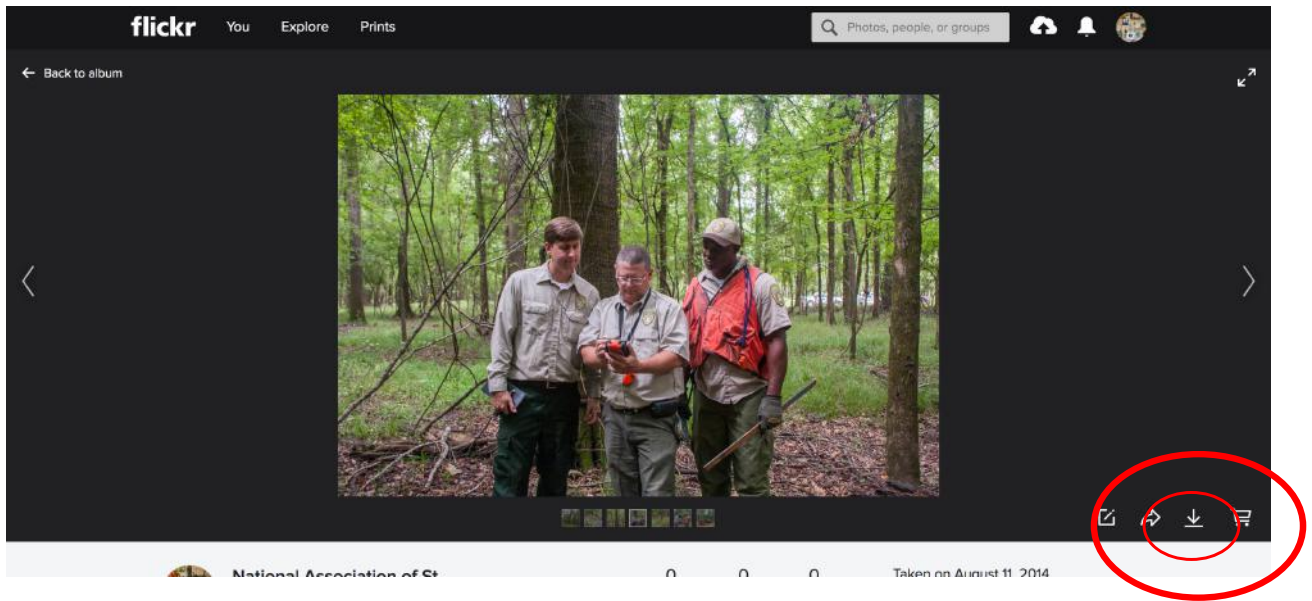

We suggest searching for photos using the album view (pictured below). This way, you can browse photos by state and year without having to guess the right keyword or tag.



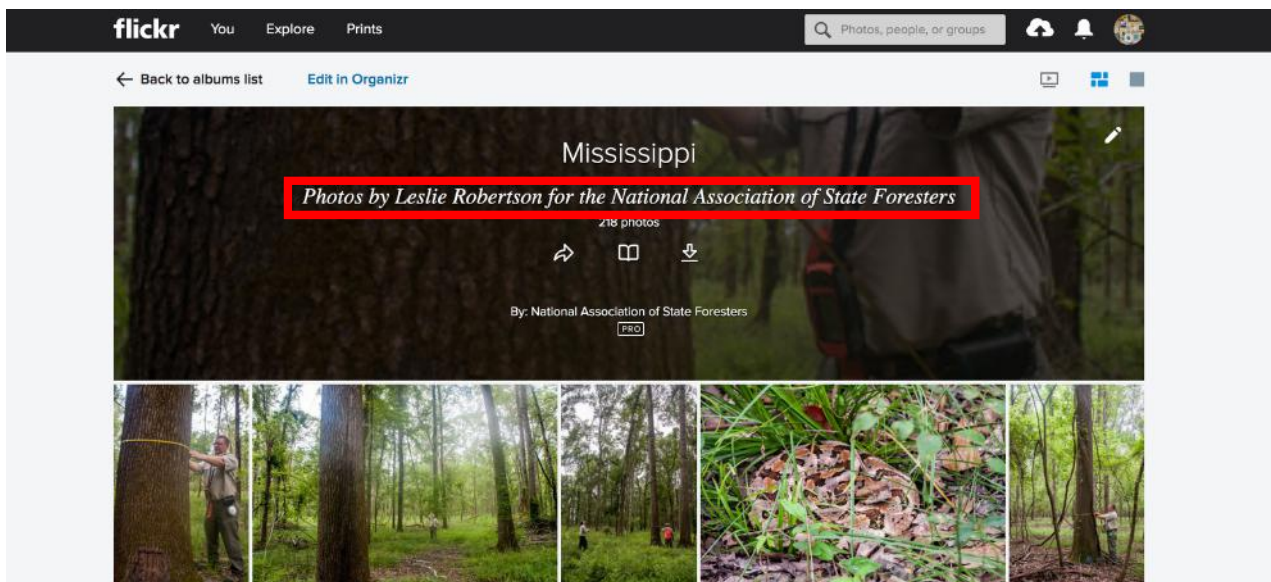

Once you've selected a photo you'd like to use, click the download button (highlighted below) and select the size photo you would like to download.

Finally, **ALWAYS** make sure when you use any NASF photo to give appropriate credit to the photographer. The appropriate attribution language for NASF-contract photographers is listed in the title of each Flickr photo album (an example is highlighted below).
