Program Highlights

Forest Health Protection

A variety of pests and pathogens were observed in District street trees, including emerald ash borer, anthracnose, bacterial leaf scorch, Dutch elm disease (DED), and an unresolved disease affecting leaves and buds of young sweetgums. Management of DED in street tree elms included 68 elm removals and fungicide injection of 482 elms.

Urban and Community Forestry

The Urban Forestry Division planted 8,085 trees in public space in the 2017-2018 planting season.
