Program Highlights

Forest Health Protection

Anthraxnose and other foliar diseases were high as a result of higher than average precipitation levels. Emerald ash borer (EAB) was found on five purple panel traps in New Castle County and EAB larvae were found on dying trees in one western Sussex County location. Spotted Lanternfly adults were found this fall in many locations in northern New Castle County, in contrast to the previous year, where only one adult had been found in the state.
